RE: Compliance with EU Directive 2002/95 EC on the Restriction of Hazardous Substances

Dear Ms. Kimberly Dugan,

NSF International Toxicology Services Department has conducted a review of the formulation disclosure information and/or testing of Blockade (BcUP 9). Based on the results of this evaluation, the products listed do not contain prohibited substances listed in Article 4 of EU Directive 2002/95 EC on the Restriction on the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment, as amended by Commission Decision of 18 August 2005 (2005/618/EC), Commission Decision of 13 October 2005 (2005/717/EC), Commission Decision of 21 October 2005 (2005/747/EC), Commission Decision of 21 April 2006 (2006/310/EC), and Commission Decision of 12 October 2006 (2006/692/EC). Under this directive, lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls and polybrominated diphenyl ethers are prohibited in the manufacture of electrical and electronic equipment with the exception of those items listed in the Annex of the Directive.
